
Emphasis on Distribution

- Keep product moving
- Identify choke points
- Identify opportunities to redirect product
- Moving undesirable product into non-disaster distribution networks
- Moving desirable product into the disaster distribution network





Concept of the Operation



New Donations Management Annex


- Developed through the Oklahoma VOAD Donations Management and Volunteer Management Committees
- Based on the MOU's The City of Oklahoma City had signed with Goodwill Industries of Central Oklahoma
- Used much of the structure developed ad hoc in the U.S. Virgin Islands during 2017 response
- Approximately a year of planning, discussion, and development





Emphasis on Digital Communications

- Donations Offer Boards
 - Call Center View
 - Partner Agency Boards
 - Donations Manager
- Points of Distribution Boards
- Digital Inventory
- Community Request Board







Public Messaging Communications

- Work closely through the Oklahoma VOAD Donations
 Management and Mass Care Committees
- Quick follow up with reported needs from local communities
- Aggressively publishing Donations Offer Hotline
- Aggressively messaging to not send "stuff"





Scope of the Operation

- 211 Donations Offers Call Center
- 2 Main Distribution Hubs
- 3 to 4 Distribution Warehouses (Dependent upon scope of event)
- Hot Shot Crews Addressing local transportation needs
- Transportation Assets
- Staff Support to run warehouses
- Donations Coordinator from the private sector
- Multiple partner agencies committed
- Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management Homeland Security (ODEMHS) to provide WebEOC board communications
- ODEMHS to provide reimbursement to MOU signees as defined under MOU






Case Study – OK-DR4438





A Case Study of OK-DR4438

- Oklahoma Severe Storms,
 Straight-line Winds, Tornadoes,
 And Flooding
 - May 7 to June 9, 2019
- Total impacted Counites
 - IA Declared 27 Counties
 - PA Declared Counties 50







Deploying a Donations Annex

- Memorandum of Understanding Signed between Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management Homeland Security and Oklahoma VOAD on May 1st, 2019
- Immediately activated to support the April/May severe weather and flooding
- Transportation assets, technical expertise, facility assets, available product



Key Learnings





Integrating Counties and Cities

- Identify community Distribution Centers (open to the public) or POD sites
- Local hotshot capacity
 - Supplement with VOAD Member Support
- County or regional Distribution Warehouse facilities
- Know where your gaps are: transportation assets, staffing, volunteers, warehouse facilities, product





Supporting Local Communities

- So new it was unclear how to have a collaborative approach during the event
- Emphasis on building out infrastructure and capacity and working with organic local developments
- Capable of moving product quickly to locally identified distribution centers and removing undesirable product from community centers





Reimbursement Process

- Documentation is critical
- Need to develop a streamlined invoicing document
- Outline the invoicing process for the State and Oklahoma VOAD
- Capturing the value of donated product and volunteer activity critical from a State Match perspective
- Oklahoma VOAD Member Benefits





Integrating Bulk Distribution

- Identify best practices to support moving bulk distribution supplies through the donations network
- Streamlines in-bounding and out-bounding product and transportation asset use
- Provide a just-in-time movement of crucial supplies and avoid stockpiling
